

Enel Call for Ideas Online 2021-2022 REGULATIONS

1. THE ORGANIZER

The Call for Ideas is designed and organized by **Campus Party** (hereafter "Organizer").

2. CALL FOR IDEAS

Campus Party holds the Call for Ideas Play Energy. The call for ideas is international and will be open from **December 23th 2021** to **January 24th 2022**. The final awarding event will take place online on **January 27th**. Because of technical or organizational needs, Campus Party reserves the right to change the closing date or time of the competition.

3. PARTICIPANTS

The **Call for Ideas Play Energy** is an **international** competition and it's addressed to **students, PhDs, young professionals** and **startups**, who can participate as individuals or as a team.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE CHALLENGE

We are looking for innovative solutions based on Open Data to improve Public Services to advance innovation in circular cities.

Solutions should address a real pain point of cities and produce valuable outputs through open data as well as support Enel's commitment to SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) with specific emphasis on SDG9 and SDG11.

How can cities improve Public Services with innovative solutions based on Open Data? Which new indicators could be added to the Enel X solutions for Municipalities in order to improve the quality of life of citizens? How can tomorrow's cities be more sustainable, circular and citizen-centric using Open Data?

5. DEADLINE AND APPLICATION

The outputs and related documentation can be presented until **January 24th, 2022**. During this time, the participants (physical people) can submit their participation by filling the following application form: **<https://treeform.typeform.com/to/RBPfC9GI>**

6. ADMISSION CRITERIA AND RULES OF PARTICIPATION

To participate at the Call for Ideas each participant must entirely and unconditionally accept these Regulations, register as indicated in the same and read and accept the Privacy Policy.

Accepting these Regulations, each participant declares that he or she is aware of the civil and criminal responsibilities deriving from any false declarations provided at the time of registration and therefore he declares that the personal information provided at the time of registration is true.

Each participant and each team also declare that any decision made by the jury nominated by the Organizer regarding the event will be accepted unconditionally.

Every communication about the challenge and the student workshop will be sent by email to the address indicated on the registration form. If the address is incorrect or in any case it is not possible to deliver the email, the participant will be automatically excluded. If the information provided at the time of registration are incomplete or false, the candidate will be excluded from the competition.

The Organizer reserves the right to verify the identity of the participant, the authenticity and correctness of the data provided at the moment of registration. Failure to provide the documents that allow the identification of the participant, or the non-conformity of the information entered with truth or the reasonable suspicion that such information is false, incorrect, out of date or incomplete, will result in the exclusion of the participant from the competition in addition to any legal actions that the Organizer may decide to undertake.

7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By accepting these Regulations and participating and the participation to Call for Ideas Play Energy, each participant undertakes, for the whole duration of the event, to use the digital space and the tools eventually made available by the organizer or its partners, with the utmost care and diligence and to strictly adhere to the rules of safety and conduct, and possibly to account for any damage to persons or property. Each participant acknowledges and agrees that the participation is free of charge and that it does not determine the right to receive any compensation, any title, and/or reimbursement of expenses.

8. RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Organizer and its partners will not be responsible in case of failure or incomplete receipt of the electronic registration and/or the Documentation for any reason. In this regard, participants are reminded that the Internet, servers, the Site and the Platform may be subject to technical difficulties, maintenance

works or malfunction which may cause network slow-downs or make access and any other connection to the Platform, to the Site, to the online registration form and/or to the upload form impossible.

In addition, the Organizer does not take charge of any connection malfunctions of the individual participants that prevent the participation of the same or the team in all or part of the competition. Each participant is exclusively responsible for his/her own internet access and for the connection costs of the same. Each participant accepts this limit of functionality and takes on the test the good functionality of the connection method of the IT system and of the Internet resources that he/she intends to use from time to time to register, insert the Documentation and participate in the competition.

Each participant takes part in Call for Ideas Play Energy at his / her own risk and is exclusively responsible for his / her design, documentation, equipment and IT supply. Therefore, each Participant undertakes, as of now, to release the Organizer from any and all liability related to the Call for Ideas Play Energy indemnify and hold harmless the Organizer and its partners from any request or claim, also for damages, which may be presented, for any reason, in relation to the Call for Ideas Play Energy, the Documentation or in any case defined by his or her participation in the event.

The Organizer can't be responsible for any theft, damaging or loss of the equipment or properties.

9. WARRANTIES

By participating to Call for Ideas Play Energy and accepting this Regulation, each participant:

- expressly declares and warrants that the output and the related documentation is made by the same person/team, is original and does not in any way, in whole or in part, infringe the intellectual or industrial property rights of third parties. Shall fully defend and hold Campus Party harmless from any and all liability, claims for damages and / or compensation, expenses, including legal expenses and costs that may be advanced by any other participant or third party related to the title to or violation in any form of the proprietary rights by the output or its connected Documentation.
- acknowledges that each project carried out is the property of Enel and Enel Group of Companies
 - which assumes the burden and full responsibility for the possible protection of the same and the inventive and/or original aspects through the means set up for this purpose by the law (registration, patent or similar, as appropriate);

- grants the Organizer and the Partners the right, free of charge, not exclusive, to publish the project on websites and social networks.

10. CODE OF CONDUCT

The Call for Ideas Play Energy is intended as an ethical event; therefore, participants are required to respect this principle and to comply with the following Code of Conduct at each stage of the competition and, in particular, to:

- respect the Regulations, the Brief, the calendar and the Path by accepting the decisions taken by the Organizer, the collaborating partners and / or the jury.
- show respect towards the other participants, the staff and the other members and / or delegated subjects of the Organizer, by the collaborating partners and / or by the host structure;
- the following actions will be considered as infringements, based on the unquestionable judgment of the Organizer and the collaborating partners: o use of language and / or of offensive, defamatory expressions that incite violence and / or discrimination, which invades privacy, which are illegal or which contain advertising, political/ideological contents or religious statements;
- the publication, transmission or diffusion, in any way, of illegal, harmful, violent, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory images, materials and / or contents and / or which can be considered harmful to the dignity personal or that are offensive, vulgar, obscene, detrimental to the privacy of others, racists, classists, blasphemous, contrary to good behaviour or public order or otherwise reprehensible or which suggest an inappropriate use of the activities that take place according to the Call for Ideas Play Energy;
- the presentation of documents and / or the use, in any way, of documentation, contents and / or materials that are not original, that involve the violation of industrial and / or intellectual property rights - including those of use and use of third parties;
- the publication, transmission or diffusion, in any way, intentionally or unintentionally, of any material that contains viruses or other codes, files or programs created to intervene, to destroy or to limit the functioning of the software, hardware or telecommunications systems of third parties, included the website/systems where University challenge is supported; - the alteration of data entered by others;
- the carrying out of operations, intentional or not, which influence or compromise the regular functionality or which limit the use for other users of

the Platform, the Site, the services, servers, networks connected, even indirectly, by the Platform, from the Site, from the hosting structure and / or from the Organizer and the collaborating partners;

- violation, intentional or otherwise, of any applicable law or regulation; - cheating or attempting to cheat;

- any other conduct, fraudulent or unauthorized that may even negatively affect the other Participants or the competition or, in any case, compromise the successful outcome and/or image of the Competition, of the Organizer and of the collaborating partners and/or, in general, of **Campus Party** and its partners.

Any violation of the Regulation and / or the Code of Conduct or conduct from which it may be alleged an unlawful and/or violating behaviour of this Regulation as well as any irregularities committed before or during the competition will involve, as appropriate and on the basis of the unquestionable decision of the Organizer, failure to participate, expulsion or disqualification of the participant and/or withdrawal of the prize already awarded and the removal of any material and/or content possibly already sent or published.

11. DATA PROTECTION AND USE OF THE RECORDINGS MADE DURING THE EVENT

Participants are aware that, during the Call for Ideas Play Energy, the organizer and/or its partners will make audio/video recordings that might also be of interest to the participants.

Participants authorize, as of now, the organizer and its business partners, as well as its successors, agents and dealers, to use - free of charge, in perpetuity for the whole world even in a partial, modified or adapted form - their personal data as well as their own image, the photos, audio/video registrations of his or her person, the environment, objects, documents photographed or recorded during the course of the event.

The authorization specified above implies the granting of a non-exclusive, transferable license to third parties, for the use of the above listed for cultural and educational purposes as well as for activities of disclosure and communication of the Organizer for advertising and promotional purposes, including streaming, publication on the Platform and on the Site and / or on any other websites and in the press, distribution and broadcast on public and private televisions and

includes, by way of example and without limitation, copyright and other rights related to its exercise as well as the rights of publication, reproduction, multiplication in copies and storage of the same also in electronic form, translation, transcription, transfer to other formats, editing, adaptation, elaboration and reduction, communication and distribution to the public, projection, transmission and diffusion and all the above also in summary version and / or reduced, in any way or form, with any procedure and on any support, by any known technological means for the purposes and within the limits defined above.

It's always excluded any use that could cause injury, harm the reputation or the dignity of the person recorded.

12. JURY AND EVALUATION

The projects submitted will be evaluated by a jury nominated by the Organizer. The jury shall nominate one winning team evaluated on the below criteria:

- Novelty and creativity;
- Realism of the proposed solution;
- Maturity level of the proposal;
- Overall scientific and technical feasibility of the proposed solution;
- Economic potential of concept (e.g. Total Cost of Ownership);
- Business potential for Enel.

Each participant and each team declare that any decision made by the jury nominated by the Organizer regarding the event will be accepted unconditionally.

The jury shall express a judgment from 1 to 5 for each evaluating criteria.

13. PRIZE

The jury shall nominate one (1) winner (the “**winner**” or “ **winning team**”) that has gained the best evaluation from the jury.

The prize is equivalent to an amount of **3000,00 euros in Amazon Coupons**.

14. MISCELLANEOUS

If any of the provisions contained in these Regulations were declared invalid or not applicable, this provision will not be considered and all other provisions will remain fully valid and effective.

15. APPLICABLE LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

These rules are governed by Italian law. Except in cases where jurisdiction is necessarily established by law, for all disputes arising from the interpretation or execution of these Regulations, the court of Rome will have exclusive jurisdiction, with the express waiver of the participants to any exception with respect to this forum.
